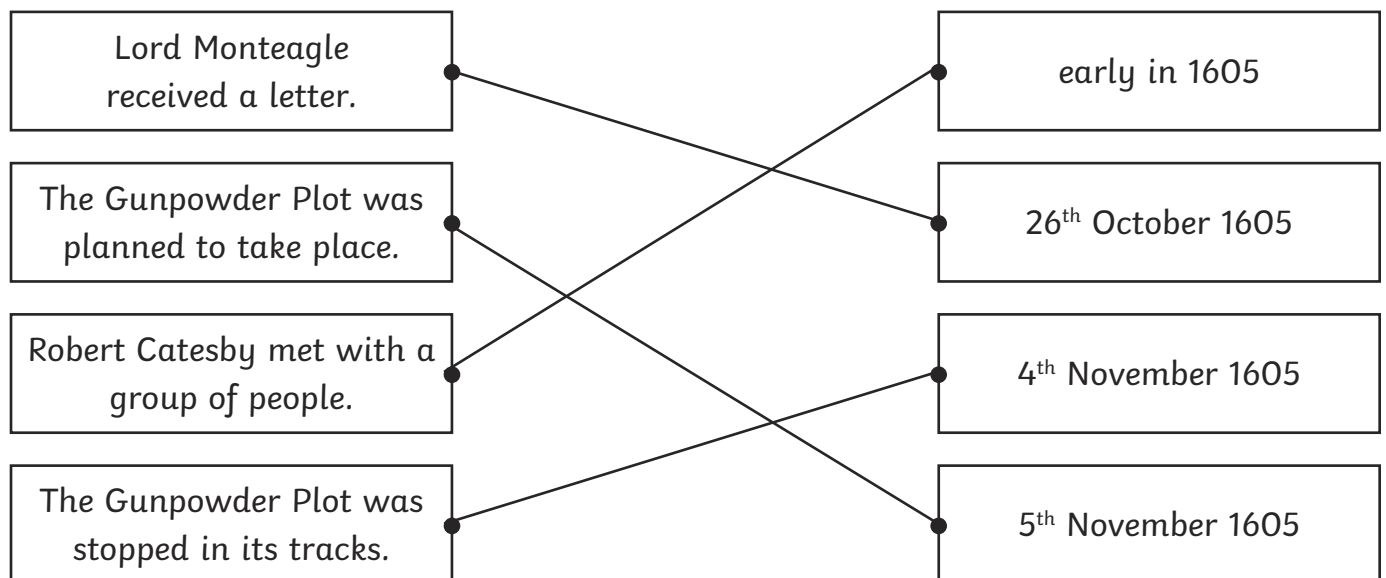
1. Who did Lord Monteagle show the letter that he had received to? Tick one.
