HEAD LICE

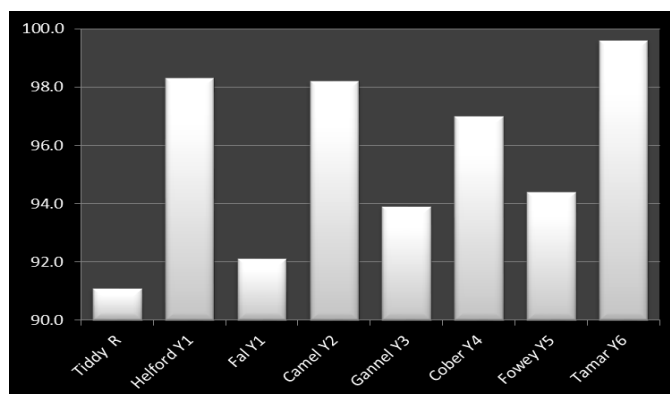
