Year 6 Spring 1 Curriculum Sequence 2023/2024

Science

Intent: To be able to recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.

SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

1. To be able to describe the importance of exercise and how it affects the heart.

2. To understand that regular exercise is important for a healthy body.

3. To be able to explain how diet and exercise affect the body.

4. To be able to recognise the impact of drugs and alcohol on the way bodies function.

Key Vocabulary aorta, arteries, atrium, blood vessels, capillaries, carbon dioxide, circulatory system, deoxygenated, heart, lungs, nutrients, organ, oxygen, oxygenated, pulse respiration, veins, vena cava, ventricle, via

Impact: Children are able to recognise how their diet, exercise and lifestyle affects how their bodies function. Children can discuss the impact of drugs and lifestyle on the way bodies function.

PSHE

Intent: To be able to set their own goals and know how to make the world a better place

SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

1. I know my learning strengths and can set challenging but realistic goals for myself (e.g. one in-school goal and one out-ofschool goal)

Intent: To be able read a picture and analyse it and then create their own artwork to convey a message

SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

1.To understand how to analyse a painting.

2. To understand how to find meaning in painting.

3. To apply drama techniques to explore the meaning of a painting.

4. To apply interpretation skills to analyse and respond to an abstract painting.

5. To understand how art can tell stories or portray messages.

6. To develop starting points for creative outcomes.

7. To demonstrate an understanding of painting techniques to make personal choices.

Key Vocabulary: abstract, analyse artist, compose, compositions convey, evaluation, inference, interpret justify, meaning, medium, mixed media, narrative

Impact: Children to produce a final piece of work, selecting appropriate tools and materials to create an intended effect.

SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

2. To plan the theme and content for a blog.

3. To understand how to write a blog. To consider the effect upon the audience of changing the visual properties of the blog.

To understand the importance of regularly updating the content of a blog. 4. To understand how to contribute to an existing blog. To understand how and why blog posts are approved by the teacher.

5. To understand the importance of commenting on blogs. To peer-assess blogs against the agreed success criteria.

Impact: Children can plan and write their own blog.

Intent: To develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance in the context of circuit training.

SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

1. To understand ways to exercise safely.
