# Year 1 Autumn 1 - 2023

### Science

Intent: To observe changes across the four seasons and to describe the weather associated with each season.

#### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To observe the changes across the four seasons.
- 2. To observe and describe the weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

Key Vocabulary: season, change, temperature, rainfall, hemisphere, globe, equator, day, night, sunrise, sunset, annual, average weather, climate

Impact: Children can name the four seasons and describe the weather associated with each.

## Geography

Intent: To observe changes across the four seasons and to describe the weather associated with each season.

#### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. Order the months of the year and recognise seasons.
- 2. Identify differences between the seasons.
- 3. Identify the different types of clothing worn in different seasons.
- 4. Identify the types of weather we have in the UK and record the local daily weather.
- 5. Explore how weather affects activities and jobs.

**Key Vocabulary:** Antarctica, Earth, rain, season, snow, sunshine, temperature, wind, Arctic, inside, outside, polar

Impact: Children can name the four seasons and describe the weather associated with each.

### Art

Intent: To name primary colours and use them to make secondary colours. To experiment with shades.

### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To investigate how to mix secondary colours.
- 2. To apply knowledge of colour mixing when painting.
- 3. To explore colour when printing.
- 4. To experiment with paint mixing to make a range of secondary colours.
- 5. To apply their painting skills when working in the style of an artist.

Key Vocabulary: blend, hue, kaleidoscope, pattern, mix, primary colour, print, secondary colour, shade, shape, space, texture, thick

Impact: Children can name primary colours and use them to create secondary colours. RE Intent: To re-tell the Christian creation story and understand how it influences Christians behaviour.

### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To consider where the Earth and natural objects came from.
- 2. To understand where Chrisitians believe the world came from.
- 3. To think about how Christians believe that God wants them to look after the world.
- 4. To consider ways in which people can look after the world.

**Key Vocabulary:** creation, God, Christians, Christianity, natural, world

Impact: Children can re-tell the Christian creation story and explain what it means to Christians.

# Year 1 Autumn 1 - 2023

### PSHE

Intent: To know that I belong in my class and understand how to work well with others.

#### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To know how to use the Jigsaw Journal.
- 2. To understand the rights and responsibilities as a member of my class.
- 3. To know that my views are valued.
- 4. To recognise the choices I make and understand the consequences.
- 5. To understand my rights and responsibilities within our Learning Charter.

**Key Vocabulary:** safe, special, calm, belonging, special, rights, responsibilities, learning charter, rewards, proud, consequences, upset, disappointed

Impact: Children feel part of the class and understand their rights and responsibilities.

## Computing

Intent: To understand how to use computers safely. To sort items on the computer.

### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To log in safely and understand why that is important.
- 2. To learn how to find saved work.
- 3. To become familiar with the resources in the Topics section.
- 4. To explore the tools area of Purple Mash.
- 1. To sort items using a range of criteria.
- 2. To sort items on the computer using 'Grouping' activities.

**Key Vocabulary:** alert, device, log in, My Work Area, avatar, file name, log out, notification, private, button, icon, menu, password, criteria, groups, sort

Impact: Children can use computers safely and can sort items using a range of criteria.

### PE

Intent:

1. To create a seasons dance.

2. To throw and catch with accuracy.

### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To move in response to a video stimulus.
- 2. To improvise and create movements with a partner.
- 3. To understand mirroring and use this with a partner.
- 4. To keep in time with a steady beat to perform a traditional style of dance.
- 5. To vary the shape and speed of movements to represent an object.

### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. To track and receive a ball.
- 2. To bounce a ball with control.
- 3. To throw and catch.
- 4. To throw and catch a ball with a partner.
- 5. To throw overarm.
- 6. To throw a quoit.

**Key Vocabulary:** travel, jump, spin, shape, motif, control, improvise, cooperate, partner, unison, beat, throw, catch, track, receive, throw, catch, overarm

Impact: Children can create a seasons dance. Children can throw and catch with increasing accuracy. Music Intent: To create a class

performance - with singing and playing.

### SEQUENCE OF LESSONS

- 1. Sing the song.
- 2. Sing the song and play instrumental parts within the song.
- 3. Sing the song and improvise using voices and/or instruments within the song.
- 4. Sing the song and perform composition(s) within the song.
- 5. Choose what you perform today.
- Start to prepare for the end of unit performance.
- 6. Prepare for the end of unit performance.

Key Vocabulary: bass, pulse, rhythm, pitch, improvise, compose, perform, audience, imagination, tempo, dynamics, timbre, texture

Impact: Children can create a class performance with singing and playing.
