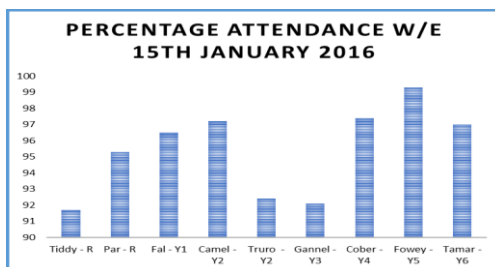
STAR LEARNERS
