COVID 19

You will be aware that we have had an increasing number of confirmed cases of Covid-19 within the school this week. Students and staff who have tested positive are isolating. Control measures are in place within the school and we are working with Cornwall Public Health and the trust to ensure we reduce the transmission in school.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following:

- · a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your children have any of the symptoms above please ensure you carry out an LFD or PCR test. LFD tests can be obtained from pharmacies or by ordering online at Order coronavirus (COVID-19) rapid lateral flow tests - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk).

PCR tests can be booked online at https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test.

Please note: Children who have tested positive for COVID-19 should self-isolate at home until they are well (48 hours fever free) **and** either:

- a) 10 full days have passed, or
- b) They have produced two negative LFD tests at least 24 hours apart, with the first taken no earlier than day 5.

Please inform school if your child tests positive and follow the government guidelines.
