## ST AUSTELL TORCHLIGHT CARNIVAL

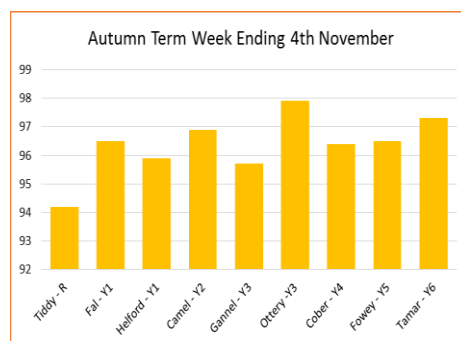
